Concurrent / Discussant Sessions:

Concurrent sessions will be organized as regular, discussant or roundtable sessions. The regular concurrent and discussant sessions will be composed of contributed papers, whose submitted abstracts will undergo double-blind peer review. Discussant sessions will include a designated chair/discussant and additional time per speaker to facilitate in-depth academic discussions on each presentation. Preference for inclusion in a discussant session shall be indicated during abstract submission. Full paper submission is required for inclusion in a discussant session.

Roundtable Sessions:

Roundtable sessions will be organized as collaborative conversation sessions. The topics and speakers of a Roundtable Session will be proposed by its organizing chair, to be approved by the Program Committee. Applications for organizing a roundtable session shall be sent to info@iaee2025.org.tr

Poster Session:

Poster session entrants must be at student status at the time of abstract submission. Abstracts for poster presentation will undergo a double-blind peer review. Preference for inclusion in the poster session shall be indicated during abstract submission.

Abstract Submission:

Authors wishing to make concurrent session presentations must submit an abstract that briefly describes the material to be presented by the abstract submission deadline, August 2nd, 2025. The abstract must be no more than two pages in length and must include the following sections:

- Overview of the topic including its background and potential significance;
- Methodology: how the matter was addressed, what techniques were used;
- Results: key and ancillary findings;
- Conclusions: lessons learned, implications, next steps;
- References (if any).

Abstracts for the poster session must be submitted by the regular abstract deadline. The abstract format for the Poster Session is identical to that for the Concurrent Sessions. Additionally, such an abstract should clearly indicate that it is intended for the Poster Session. Abstracts submitted by e-mail or in hard copy will not be processed.
